## LUGGAGE AND ID

Each student should bring two bags:

### 1 – SUITCASE

Each participant should bring one regular sized suitcase which will be checked at the airport. Airport regulations state that all bags must be tagged on the outside with the actual traveler's name and address. Do not attempt to bring weapons of any kind on the airplane as per FAA regulations.

### 2 – CARRY-ON

You should also pack a carry-on which should ideally be a backpack. This will be used on the airplane, as well as a travel bag for touring days. You will use it to carry your camera, extra clothes, gloves, water and snacks. It's also a good idea to pack personal items in the bag (such as medication, money, contact lenses or glasses) along with a change of clothing in case of luggage delays. Affix a luggage tag with the traveler's name and address on the outside.

### 3 - IDENTIFICATION

All participants must have ID with them as outlined:

16 and older: photo ID such as driver's license

Under 16, no identification is required

## CLOTHING

- JACKET – waterproof
- PANTS-waterproof
- SHOES – tennis shoes or hiking boots suitable for walking. Please bring two pairs.
- SOCKS and UNDERWEAR
- BATHING SUIT
- SHIRTS AND SWEATSHIRTS suitable for layering

## OTHER ITEMS

- WATER BOTTLE – Make sure it has a good seal so it does not leak in your backpack
- LIP BALM – at least 15 SPF
- SUNSCREEN
- CAMERA and FILM – Stock up at home, it will be much more expensive at the National Park.
- ZIPLOCK BAGS – to keep camera and film dry in the event of rain
- SNACKS – All meals are included, but you may want to bring granola bars, powerbars or other portable, sealed snacks.
- SUNDRIES – toiletries of your choice
- IT IS WISE TO LEAVE VALUABLES SUCH AS JEWELRY AND ELECTRONICS AT HOME!



## WEATHER

The weather in Yellowstone region in June is typically high temperature in the 70s and a low at night in the 30s.

As with most summer weather, especially in this region of the country you need to be prepared for anything! Make sure you are prepared with rain proof jacket and pants to wear in the event of a storm.

We could have beautiful, sunny 70 degree days or we could have cold rain. The most important thing is to be prepared for wet and cold weather with a waterproof jacket and enough layers. You can always take the layers off if it is warm.

This is an outdoor adventure, so remember to think PRACTICAL over fashionable.
